Eligibility

- · Open to artists 18 & older
- Original work only. No copies, classwork or collaborations. No reproductions of originals.
- Art must not have been previously entered in a SWA show.
- Art must be appropriate for public spaces.
- Show committee reserves the right to determine whether art meets the show or category requirements.

Entry

- Artists may enter up to 3 works of art
- Art must be ready to hang with wire that is not visible above the top of the picture.
 No saw tooth hangers or clips
- Maximum width is 28" and a maximum height is 36" for hanging art. Larger pieces must be accompanied by a display easel. (No working easels) Each artist may enter one large entry.
- Members \$15 first entry & \$10 each additional entry
- Non-members \$25 first entry, \$10 each additional entry
