# From Our President Rick Jones,

We shouldn't forget Ground Hog day on the 2nd. With less than sixty days into the New Year, our calendar is filling up quickly. On January 31st,, Pam Richey-Curtis hosted a full house workshop by Rita Sabler on Urban Sketching at Farrar's Bistro and Liz Pike opened her new gallery in Camas on the 4th. Chris Mooney has his Urban Landscape workshop scheduled for the 26th of this month and we have completed the first art installations at the Marie Gluesenkamp Perez Third Congressional District Offices on Officers Row. Rita Sabler's workshop held at Farrar's Bistro on January 29th was attended by thirty SWA members and a few non-members and everyone enjoyed both the setting and the workshop. Refreshments were part of the workshop fee and, as expected, Farrar's did an outstanding job.

Rita held a 90 minute version of her typical workshop which included:

Her philosophy behind travel sketching, what's included in her portable tool travel set and her favorite materials.

Rita also included travel drawing projects she has done recently including Sketch Tour Portugal, Camino de Santiago, and New York Reawakens which have all resulted in published books this year

She gave a quick drawing demo with workshop participants visiting her work table based on a very clever "city scheme" i.e. Rome, London, Paris, by which participants from those city tables had an opportunity to hover around Rita while she drew and explained her process.
