Saturday, March 21st, we will host Barbara De Pirro of Golden art products. Barbara will be demonstrating **Printmaking with Acrylics.**

This demonstration will have something for artists of any level. Even if you don't think you are interested in printmaking, you will come away with many new ideas and a better understanding of what Golden products can do. Join us for a lecture and demonstration of printmaking techniques using Golden acrylics. Barbara will show you many stressfree printmaking techniques, no press required. She will provide an overview of the many surfaces available for printing, as well as the array of Golden acrylic paints that are suitable for making multiple prints. 



SWA Meeting Minutes for February 19, 2020

The meeting was called to order by President Janice Tracy. Guests Linda and Michelle were introduced.

Treasurer Linda Whittingham reported a balance of \$10,801.28 in all accounts.

Diana Thewlis explained the monthly raffle. She also reminded members to check sign-up sheets for the monthly meeting snacks and room set up.

Spring Show and Sale:

- Katey Sandy talked about the Spring Show and Sale. Many volunteers will be needed and this year sign-up sheets are on-line at https://volunteersignup.org/34FKF. To date, there are 25 show entries and entries will be limited to 200. Show registration and the Prospectus is on-line at swavancouver.com.
- Kathleen Barcos explained the need for show sponsors and has materials prepared to help members approach
 potential sponsors. Sponsors help provide awards and prizes for participating artists.
- Wanda Brewster discussed the silent auction and the need for donations by members to fill auction baskets. Items
 needed include gift cards to restaurants or movies, for example, bottles of wine, hand crafted cards or journals and
 items that might be used to help fill a basket. Several auction items have been received from artists supplies
 companies. The silent auction is an important and popular part

of the Spring Show.

Janice talked about the need for a new President and Vice President. Elections for new officers will be coming in the Spring and nominations are currently being accepted.

Demonstrator for the day was member Elaine Pawski who explained how to use an iPad Pro and the ProCreate program to plan and develop art projects and paintings. Drawings are done directly on the iPad screen with an Apple Pencil and a wide range of colors are available. Elaine also teaches a class to use the iPad and the ProCreate program at Oregon Society of Artists.

The next SWA meeting will be Saturday, March 21 at Clark College, the Frost Building, Room 103. Plenty of parking is available. A representative from the Golden company will introduce some of their new products. This will also be an opportunity to bring items for the auction baskets to this meeting.

The SWA Spring Show is a professionally judged, non juried show and sale representing a wide variety of art media and disciplines. It features over \$1600 in cash prizes in 6 judged categories, many sponsor selected awards plus a People's Choice award. Karen Madsen, Artstra Board Chair will be the judge. She holds a MA in Studio Art from NY University. Her art can be viewed at kcmadsen.net.

VIEWING DATES AND TIMES

CATEGORIES

- 1. Oil and acrylic on canvas or board not under glass
- 2. Water media including watercolor, acrylic and ink
- Combined media including mixed media, digitally painted, and other combined media. No photography or digital manipulated photos.
- 4. Pencil, colored pencil, graphite, charcoal or conte
- 5. Pastels including oil and soft pastels
- 6. 3 D work including small sculpture, woodwork and glass. (No furniture)

ELIGIBILITY

- Open to all artists 18 & older.
- Original work only. No copies, classwork or collaborations.
 No reproductions of originals. No representations of famous figures such as celebrities, actors or sports personalities.
- Art must not have been previously entered in a SWA show.
- Art must be appropriate for public spaces.
- Show committee reserves the right to determine whether art meets the show or category requirements.

DELIVERY AND PICKUP

- Deliver to the Water Resource Center Community Room Tuesday, April 28, 12pm-5pm
- Pick up work on Sunday, May 3, 3:30pm-4:30pm

REGISTRATION & ENTRY

- Artists may enter up to 3 works of art.
- Art must be ready to hang with wire that is at least 2 inches below the top. No saw tooth hangers or clips. Art not properly wired may be rejected.
- Maximum width & height 36", including frame, for hanging art.
 Larger pieces are displayed on easels. Large pieces incur an additional fee and are limited to one per artist, as space allows.
 2d art must not exceed 20 lbs, 3d art must not exceed 40lbs.
- Members 1 entry- \$20; 2 entries- \$35; 3 entries- \$45
- Non-members 1entry- \$30; 2 entries- \$45; 3 entries- \$55
- Additional \$5 for pieces over 36"x 36"
- Registration fee will be invoiced via Paypal. Payment is due upon receipt. All registrations not paid by April 17 will be void.
- Registration closes on April 17, or when 200 pieces of art are registered.


