Cash awards will be given for Best in Category and 1st Place for 2D, 3D, Photography. Non-cash awards will be given for 2nd & 3rd Place for each category.

### Registration Cost: Applicants may submit up to 3 pieces.

- Members: \$25 for the first entry and \$10 for each additional piece.
- Non-members: \$35 for the first entry and \$10 for each additional piece.
- Artwork exceeding 36" x 40" will be an extra \$10 per piece. Online payment is included in the registration process. If you have trouble paying online please email [treasurer@swavancouver.com](mailto:treasurer@swavancouver.com) as soon as possible.

### Hanging Requirements:

- Maximum hanging size is 36"X40" including frame.
- Pieces larger than 36"x 40" including frame will require easels. SWA has seven easels that will accommodate pieces up to 42" x 48", and will be provided on a first come basis. Pieces over 42" x 48" must supply your own show condition easel.
- Art must be dry, framed appropriately or on gallery wrapped canvas or board, and ready to hang with wire that is 3 inches below the top of the frame and not visible above the top of the frame when hung. No sawtooth hangers or clips.
- Pieces not following these hanging guidelines will not be accepted.

### Accepted Media: 2D work in all media, 3D work in all media and Photography

- Accepted art must be original art that is primarily aesthetic
- No Giclee, Print or Canvas copies of original 2D Art except Digital Art and Photography
- No AI generated art or work copied from old masters, other artists, or from copyrighted or published materials without permission
- No work produced in step-by-step instruction classes or workshops
- Art should be created within the last 3 years and not previously been shown in a judged SWA show.
- Show managers reserve the right to determine whether art is appropriate
- SWA will handle sales and retain a 35% commission. All sold art must remain for the duration of the show and be picked up during the regular pickup hours
- Artists may bring a one-page artist biography when dropping off their art. Biographies will be included in our on-site Artists Biography Book and be available for patrons to review during the Spring Show 2025
